#### **Progress of works**

The installation of new heating distribution pipe work is now complete to all blocks.

The majority of making good to the ground works around the estate are now complete.



We have also progressed with the installation of new calorifiers (water storage vessels) within the boiler house.



The new acoustic screens and doors to the boiler house have been installed.



#### Progress of works cont:

We are now working on the installation of the new distribution pipe work and valves to the hot water supply system in both the Camden and Lomax underground car parks.

This will improve the supply of hot water the blocks above these car parks

We will inform residents when the connections between the new pipe work and existing risers will take place.

The picture below shows a section of pipe removed from the hot water supply pipe work to the Ravenscar block




#### **PLEASE BEWARE!**
