Dear resident

This letter is being sent to all residents living on the Curnock Street Estate.

At Highbury Magistrates Court in January 2008 the London Borough of Camden obtained an Anti-Social Behaviour Order (ASBO) against Abdul Sharif due to his antisocial behaviour in the Camden Town area and on your estate.

Evidence of Sharif's anti-social behaviour on your estate was presented to the court, including CCTV evidence and evidence from joint police, housing, warden and Safer Streets Team walkabouts on estates.

The order obtained against Mr Sharif prevents him from:

- Entering into certain specified areas of Camden and the City of Westminster (which includes your estate)
- Having in his possession or control, in any public place within the London boroughs of Camden, Islington and Westminster any item made, adapted or intended for use in relation to the supply, production or consumption of any controlled drug, other than any needle or syringe that is capped and does not contain any liquid or substance.



The order to remain in force for eight years

Taking legal action of this type is always a last resort. However, if people repeatedly cause our residents harassment, alarm and distress we will seek to protect you in this way. If you see Mr Sharif on your estate, call the St Pancras and Somers Town Safer Neighbourhood Team or Housing Patrol on the numbers below. Any information will be treated in confidence.

## **Reporting antisocial behaviour**

- Call 999 to report urgent incidents
- The police Safer Neighbourhoods number for non-emergencies is 020 8721 2810
- Housing Patrol – call 020 7974 8205, 6pm-2am every day. If the patrol witness any activity they will report this back to the Housing Office and can be witnesses in court
